



A pattern is a repeated image used to create a decorative design.

They can be made from simple lines, from shapes, or from pictures, from one colour, or lots of colours, but they always repeat. Here are some examples of patterns.




Do you know what any of these patterns are called? Write the names in the boxes.

Use them to inspire your own patterns.




Sarah by Alison Mary Allnutt.

The Muslin Dress by Philip Wilson Steer. This artist has used pattern on the sofa and the wall behind. Use pattern to decorate this sofa.






Tile teapot stand by Minton
