MAY 28TH: TIM JACKSON, PRINCIPAL HORN WITH THE RLPO, LEADS US THROUGH A FUN-FILLED AFTERNOON, PERFORMING AND CHATTING ABOUT THE HORN THROUGH THE AGES.

JUNE 4TH: TRIO ROUGE. RECENT GRADUATES OF LEEDS UNIVERSITY PRESENT A PROGRAMME OF CLASSICAL AND ROMANTIC MUSIC FOR CLARINET, VIOLA & PIANO, INCLUDING TRIOS BY MOZART & BRUCH.

JUNE 11TH: THE KAREM QUINTET (ALL RLPO PLAYERS) PERFORMS THE RARELY HEARD G MAJOR QUINTET BY DVORAK, ONE OF ONLY A FEW SERIOUS CHAMBER WORKS TO INCLUDE DOUBLE BASS.

JUNE 18TH: THE ENSEMBLE OF ST LUKE'S PERFORM STRAVINSKY'S "THREE PIECES" AND BEETHOVEN'S STRING QUARTET OP.18 NO 4.

JUNE 25TH: PIXELS ENSEMBLE. SOPHIE ROSA (VIOLIN), ALEX HOLLADAY (CELLO) AND IAN BUCKLE (PIANO) PLAY THE BRAHMS B MAJOR AND MOZART G MAJOR PIANO TRIOS.

JULY 2ND: "CHRISTOS STYLIANIDES QUINTET"..... THIS YOUNG, VIBRANT GROUP IS LED BY ONE OF SCOTLAND'S MOST GIFTED YOUNG JAZZ TRUMPETERS AND PROMISES TO BE AN EXCITING AFTERNOON OF MUSIC MAKING.

JULY 9TH: "WHITE LINES", AN ENTERTAINING GLIMPSE INTO THE REAL WORLD OF CONTEMPORARY MUSIC!

JULY 16TH: DAN KEMSELL TRIO, THREE YOUNG JAZZ MUSICIANS FROM BIRMINGHAM CONSERVATOIRE LED BY RISING GUITARIST DANIEL KEMSELL.

JULY 23RD: NEIL CAMPBELL (GUITAR). MUSIC WILL BE MAINLY ORIGINAL AND WILL DRAW FROM NEIL'S ALBUMS 'THROUGH THE LOOKING GLASS', 'NIGHT SKETCHES', 'GHOST STORIES', TABULA RASA SUITE' AND 'EMERGENCE'.

JULY 30TH: SOLOISTS OF THE ORCHESTRA DELL'ARTE, NONET FOR WIND AND STRINGS BY LOUIS SPOHR, PLUS A LITTLE OF BEETHOVEN.

AUGUST 6TH: RICHARD CASEY, PIANIST, WILL PLAY A FASCINATING PROGRAMME, CENTRING ON VISTA BY ANTHONY POWERS, SURROUNDED BY MANUEL DE FALLA'S TRIBUTES TO FELLOW COMPOSERS DEBUSSY AND DUKAS PLAYED ALONGSIDE THEIR OWN MUSIC.

AUGUST 13TH: MODERN JAZZ FROM THE OLLY CHALK TRIO, GRADUATES FROM BIRMINGHAM CONSERVATOIRE; OLLY CHALK, HAILED AS ONE OF THE MOST GIFTED PIANO PLAYERS OF HIS GENERATION, IS HERE WITH SERENADE REGULARS SAM INGVOSEN (BASS) AND GWILYM JONES (DRUMS).

AUGUST 20TH: POPULAR LOCAL SOPRANO HEATHER HEIGHWAY (SOPRANO) ACCOMPANIED BY PIANIST TIM KENNEDY, JOINED BY TENOR, JOSEPH BUCKMASTER, AND CLARINETTIST DAVID CANTILLON, FOR A PROGRAMME OF GERMAN MUSIC INCLUDING SCHUBERT'S SHEPHERD ON A ROCK, MOZART ARIAS AND SONGS BY BEETHOVEN, BRAHMS, LEHAR AND WOLF, WITH JOHAN STRAUSS II.

AUGUST 27TH: AN ALPINE ADVENTURE FROM SOLOISTS FROM **ORCHESTRA DELL'ARTE** PLAY SONGS AND JOLLY TUNES WITH AN ALPINE THEME TO ROUND OFF THE SUMMER PROGRAMME.
